If you submit a form please note the following:

- **PLEASE WRITE YOUR NAMES IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER.**
- **Family Surnames only** will be published (no Christian names please).
- Please indicate the **Country** if not UK, **County** and, if you wish, more specific location(s) e.g. town(s) or village(s).
- For '**Period**' indicate **a,b,c,d,**or **e** (a=16<sup>th</sup> Century, b=17<sup>th</sup> Century, c=18<sup>th</sup> Century, d=19<sup>th</sup> Century, e= 20<sup>th</sup> Century or later).
- **New members are limited to eight entries in their first year of membership.**
- Extra notes may be added to the back of the form but they will only be considered for inclusion on the website (i.e. not the journal). However, items may be sent to the **society editor** (address in journal) for publication in the HELP WANTED or HELP OFFERED columns of the journal. You are positively encouraged to send to the Journal Editor articles on subjects of interest to other members - e.g. your problems or successes.
- **Please indicate clearly on the top of the form whether or not you want your interests shown on the society's web site by deleting the 'DO' or 'DO NOT' as appropriate.**
- **Members may have their postal address and/or their Email address displayed on the web site. Once again, please indicate your preference on the top of the form as above.** Note that if you do not allow at least one of either your email address or postal address to be shown then you cannot be contacted from the web site and there is no point in a web site entry. You may still submit your form if you only want your interest and contact details shown in the society's journal.
- If you have your own personal family history web site, you are encouraged to request a hyperlink to it on your interests page. A request for a link, including the website address, may be added to the back of the form and this will then be checked and considered for publication on your interest page.
- Once your interest have been published, we will publish only substantial changes in the Journal but you may submit additions, deletions or amendments for your web site entries at any time - either by post using the address below or by email to: [webmaster@bafhs.org.uk](mailto:webmaster@bafhs.org.uk).
